1.0 Call to Order & Pledge of Allegiance

3.0 Special Presentations:

San Bernardino County Public Works: Andy Silao, Mervat Mikhail and Pol Arsua from SB County Public Works gave a presentation regarding a repaving project on Hospital Road in Lake Arrowhead. The project will begin after Labor Day weekend. It will take approx. 10 days for Torrey/Rouse Roads and 15 days for Hospital Road including sewer. There will be temporary lighting along Torrey/Rouse Roads. No parking on Torrey/Rouse Roads during construction. They answered questions from the audience

- a. Michelle Wimmer: Gave a presentation regarding insurance issues occurring in the mountain communities. She discussed several topics including non-admitted carriers (out of state), California Fair Plan, extreme zip code areas, and fire line score. She encouraged everyone to share their concerns with his or her Senator and Assemblyman as well as the California Insurance commission.

4.0 Community Input: Items discussed included Church of the Woods, KKK fliers, and the Lake Arrowhead Film Festival.

Committee Member Scott L. Rindenow

- SB County Sherriff: Lt. Lupear shared it is the slow time on the mountain. It has been quiet. The station is fully staffed. He reminded people to keep their cars locked. There has been an increase in theft involving unlocked cars in the Crestline area.
- California Highway Patrol: Officer Carter reminded everyone of black ice that still exists in some areas. . April is distracted driver month. The Age Well Drive Smart class will be held on April 26 at the San Moritz Lodge.
- Lake Arrowhead Village: Vicki Goodglick announced the concert series for this summer. They are changing the starting time to 7 pm. Wrist banding for tables and age id. New general manager.

Committee Member Ken Stowe

- SB County Fire: Steve Tracey, BC, introduced himself. Chief Opliger has been promoted and Ron Walls is now interim Division Chief. Rehabbing the old fire station on Lake Drive in Crestline. There have been issues with spring water affecting both homes and businesses as well as on roads creating black ice.
- Cal Fire: Brett Taylor shared that currently they only have Running Springs staffed. They will be fully staffed in late April. Upcoming training at the Cedar Glen Boy Scout Camp.
- US Forest Service: Brian Grant says USFS is doing road assessment of Forest Service roads. Discussed some prescribed burns. Discussed Facebook page.

- Friends of Lake Arrowhead Mountain Communities: David Caine said they have had no news from the FAA.
- Lake Arrowhead Resort & Spa: Daniel introduced himself and stated that they will be attending community meetings. Launching their boat this weekend. Discussed upcoming events.

- Lake Arrowhead Communities Chamber of Commerce: Robin Bull shared that the Chamber Awards Gala was a big success. She shared several events that are coming up in the near future.

Committee Member Duane Banner

- Rim of the World Association of Realtors: Carol Banner shared that the insurance issue is affecting them. Vacation rental market is booming. Things typically pick up at this time of year.
- Catherine Cerri from LACSD reminded everyone that irrigation starts May 1st. Start later if you can and save water.
- Rim of the World Historical Society: Duane Banner shared that the Museum will be opening soon and the Wooden Boat show is in June.

- a. **Short Term Rentals:** Rindenow discussed the committee he formed to look to suggestion and recommendations. Murray provided copies of the most current draft version of the STR code.
