Council Member Scott L. Rindenow

- SB County Sherriff: Cpt. Lupear shared that because the courts are closed, those deputies have been added to patrol. Discussed “snow play” signage and parking enforcement. Staring OHV patrol. Starting next week will be doing boat patrols on Lake Arrowhead. Calls are down 30% to 40% due to Covid issue. People are being very cooperative regarding masks. Will be doing extra patrols in the Hook Creek area on weekends. He discussed and shared crime stats.
- California Highway Patrol: Sgt. Lomineck mentioned traffic is light on the mountain. DUIs are up. May is motorcycle awareness month. Keep an eye out for motorcycles.
- Lake Arrowhead Village: Erin Wiley shared that things are very challenging right now. They have 10 or 11 essential business open. Some restaurants are doing curbside pickup. Doing ongoing maintenance projects. All concerts have been canceled. Still planning on marketing the Village and making the best of the situation. CVS will be coming to the Village. A new restaurant will be opening in the old Woody’s location.
- SB County Fire: Chief Walls shared that County Fire has been taking precautions related to the Covid issue. They have instigated new procedures to protect staff. Calls have been down during the stay at home order. Chief Walls reminded everyone that fire season is coming and he encouraged everyone to be prepared.
- Cal Trans: Shane Masood shared that the rock scaling on Hwy 18 in the narrows is complete. He will bring information regarding the Hwy 173 / Torrey Road project next month. Discussed the hwy 330 City Creek Bridge project.
- Senator Morrell’s office: Pacal Cornejo-Reynoso shared that legislatively, there is not much to report. The Senator’s staff is available via phone and email. All meeting and voting will be done remotely.
- Lake Arrowhead Communities Chamber of Commerce: Robin Bull shared the challenges the Chamber and local businesses are experiencing.
- Rim of the World Association of Realtors: Teresa Grant gave an overview of the challenges related to real estate industry due to the Covid issue. She shared some listing and sales statistics.
- Rim of the World Historical Society: Jim Grant discussed they are updating displays and cleaning up their property. The Antique and Classic Wooden Boat Show has been canceled for this year.
