Council Member Scott L. Rindenow

- SB County Sherriff: Lt. Lupear said that things are slow. Not many people on the lake. OHV patrols are out on Forest Service roads. Three large marijuana grows in the mountains have been shut down.
- California Highway Patrol: Lt. Salinas shared that there have been 5 fatal accidents this year. None last year. Coffee with a Cop on June 22 at Higher Grounds in Crestline.

Council Member Ken Stowe

- SB County Fire: Battalion Chief Steve Tracey announced the fire boat is back on Lake Arrowhead. Regarding the recent tanker fire on Hwy 18, it was a gasoline tanker that got a flat tire and the driver didn't realize it. It started a fire and medic engine 25 was there within 9 minutes. They averted what could have been a disaster. Had to close the road and offload the fuel. Structure fire in Crestline off Lake Drive. Kept the fire to the original home. Discussed possible controlled burns in late June. Chief Ron Walls introduced himself as the new division chief.

Council Member Michelle Ambrozic

- Friends of Lake Arrowhead Mountain Communities: Matthew Callas recently received an update from the FAA. Working closely with elected official's offices. Encouraged people to use the air noise button and file complaints.

- Arrowhead Lake Association: Wayne Austin discussed events over the Memorial Day weekend. This weekend is the Wooden Boat Show. Members are free to attend. 4th of July will be a great event with flyovers and increased fireworks. Working on several improvement projects. Discussed upcoming events.

Council Member Voni Saxbury

- Lake Arrowhead Communities Chamber of Commerce: Robin Bull discussed upcoming events at the Chamber. Including mixer, business over breakfast, and social media training.
- Rim of the World Association of Realtors: Carol Banner mentioned prices are up slightly. Inventory is still low.

Council Member Duane Banner

- Rim of the World Rec and Park District: Hugh Bialecki mentioned the district is in full summer mode. Gave an overview of activities and events.
- Save our Forest Association: Hugh Bialecki discussed the Blue Jay Project and the Church of the Woods project.

- Short Term Rentals:** Michelle Ambrozic provided a written report of the Short Term Rental Sub-committee with recommendations related to the revision of the Short Term Rental Ordinance. The Council members reviewed the document. Chair Rindenow then asked the Council members to vote on each recommendation separately. After all items were considered and discussed at length, the Council decided to send their recommendations as one document, and to include the report prepared by the sub-committee chaired by Michelle Ambrozic. A motion was made to submit these documents to Supervisor Rutherford. Motion: Banner. Second: Saxbury. Approved 5/0/0
- Lake Arrowhead Economic Development Study, Scott L. Rindenow:** Murray gave an update on this topic. Supervisor Rutherford met with Dr. Thornburg and is working on finding funding for the project. ,

6.0 Supervisor’s Report: Lewis Murray discussed the Board of Supervisor’s 2019/2020 budget, the issues regarding the Burrtec part time trash exemption, the Edison fliers related to possible power outages, the Hospital Road project, and the live broadcast of the Church of the Woods Planning Commission meeting at the Twin Peaks County building.
