Meeting Minutes

Thursday August 5, 2021 6:00 p.m.

1.0 Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 6:04 pm by Chair Scott Rindenow, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance

2.0 Introductions: Scott Rindenow asked the MAC Board members to introduce themselves.

3.0 Approval of Minutes: July 1, 2021 meeting: Motion to approve, Grant. Second, Stowe. Approved, 4/0/0

4.0 Announcement from MAC Board Members: Chair Scott Rindenow thanked Duane Banner for his 7 years on the MAC board.

5.0 Special Presentation:

- **Skypark / Santa's Village:** Bill Johnson gave an update on Skypark. He discussed mountain biking. They are holding racing events on certain days of the week. They are still holding Tunes in the Trees on Friday evenings. The campground has been open since September 2020. He shared that they offer Airstreams for camping at the park, so you don't have to pull a trailer up the hill. They are still offering local specials.

6.0 Community & Government Updates:

- **CHP:** Sgt. Barajas invited everyone to attend their Open House on Saturday, September 18 from 10 am to 2pm. Event will be held in the Running Springs CHP parking lot. They will be holding a car seat event on Aug 14 from 9 am to 1 pm.
- **Rim of the World Unified School District:** Cindy Gardner announced that August 11th is the first day of school. She discussed preparation days, mask requirements, and the different learning options available. So far enrollment is down by about 3% to 5%.

- **Rim of the World Education Foundation:** Evette Martinez discussed Avid, ROP, and their fundraising efforts for their programs.
- **ALA:** Bob Mattison reported the lake is 5.3 feet from full. The current temperature is 74 degrees. They recently closed the Burnt Mill Beach area due to water testing issues, but it has reopened. They have purchased a lake weed removal device. They are expecting delivery in September. He also shared a fundraising event for cancer research which will be held on the lake on September 4th.
- **Lake Arrowhead Village:** Josh Martin attended and introduced himself as the new property manager for Lake Arrowhead Village.
- **Rim of the World Association of Realtors:** Theresa Grant gave a status update of the current real estate market in the mountain communities.
- **Rim of the World Recreation and Park District:** Jenny Hueter, introduced herself as the new general manager. She discussed after-school programs and other activities.

9.0 Supervisor's Report: Lewis Murray thanked Duane Banner for his service on the Lake Arrowhead MAC. The Supervisor will accept applications for the next 30 days. He discussed the current status of the Dark Sky Ordinance. It should come before the Planning Committee in September.

Murray shared the status of short-term rental enforcement. Code Enforcement has begun to increase enforcement on evenings and weekends. They have begun issuing \$1000 fines. The County has contracted with a firm that has identified most if not all unpermitted STR. They have all received notices and are now subject to \$1000 per day fines. He also shared a link to the map showing all STR locations. A Good Neighbor brochure has been produced and is being distributed.

Regarding the construction on 50 acres +/- in Skyforest, The County issued a "stop work" order on Monday, July 26, and is requiring the property owner to apply for a grading permit. The property owner did obtain a permit with the NRCS for some brush clearance and maintenance of logging roads. However, the NRCS's approval requires the applicant to obtain local jurisdiction clearance and/or approvals (permits). We are still waiting on the engineered grading plans from the property owner and work has not continued on the site.

Regarding Covid, there are no mask retirements at this time. We now have data on the vaccination status of county residents who have tested positive for COVID-19 since February 1, 2021. 25,161 new cases since 2/1 have been among the unvaccinated, while 1,071 have been among the vaccinated. In SB County since Feb 1 only 4% of the vaccinated got Covid, which is what Pfizer and Moderna said it would be, and based on statistics reported in the news maybe 1 or 2 of those were hospitalized. Sounds about right.
