6.0 Community & Government Updates: *This is an opportunity for Community Representatives & Government agencies to update the LAMAC on items of interest to the Lake Arrowhead Communities.*

- **Sheriff:** Captain Don Lupear, SBSB discussed recent protests and the fact that they have remained peaceful. He shared that calls for service have been down for several months but are now back to a normal level. He reminded everyone that Covid related violations need to be reported to public health rather than the Sheriff's department. Sheriff's aviation will be resuming night flights over National Forest areas looking for homeless encampments. Lupear shared that he has spoken with USFS and they are considering closing the forest to dispersed camping. Boat patrols continue on Lake Arrowhead and Lake Silverwood. OHV patrols are continuing also.

- **CHP:** Sgt. O’Brian shared that CHP calls for service are also back to normal. He mentioned he has been receiving a lot of traffic calls in the Crestline area. When they respond to a call they will site any and all violations they see. He mentioned the closing of Aztec Falls has helped cut down on their call volume.
- **Lake Arrowhead Village:** Erin Wiley shared that many stores are opening including most of the outlets. Appreciative of local support. The also have several new businesses that should be opening soon. She mentioned Jetty’s, Honey Habit, California Bank and Trust, and a tenant for the old bank location. Businesses are able to utilize outdoor space. They are updating their website.
- **Rim of the World School District:** Cindy Gardner shared that they are close to completion on the exterior painting and mural at Rim High. Due to Covid issues they will be offering distance learning to Rim School District students. They have several strategies in place to address the issue. They are upgrading their cleaning procedures utilizing a disinfecting fogger machine. They are ordering additional chrome books for students. They held a Board Retreat this past July.
- **Cal Trans:** Jocelyn Whitfield addressed several questions posed at the June meeting. There was really no clear reason why the EMS where located where they were. There are more coming in 2024/2025. Where they will be located is a mystery. The Hwy 173 project is on hold due to higher than expected bids.
- **Lake Arrowhead Communities Chamber of Commerce:** Robin Bull discussed marketing strategies during Covid. Looking forward to ribbon cuttings.
- **Rim of the World Association of Realtors:** Carol Banner shared that real estate is an essential business. Lots of demand and a low supply.
- **Rim of the World Recreation and Park District:** Carley Korn discussed new programs available at ROWRPD. They are looking to assist families with school work. She share other topics and news at the Park District.

7.0 Unfinished Business: Short Term Rentals: Rindenow shared his thoughts on the upcoming Arrowhead Lake Association vote regarding lake use by short term rental customers.
