## **Supervisor Rutherford to Meet with Residents at Memorial Park in Upland**

**March 8, 2011 –UPLAND–** San Bernardino County Second District Supervisor Janice Rutherford invites residents to join her and her family as they have a picnic at Memorial Park in Upland on Saturday, March 12.

“I enjoy meeting residents face-to-face and learning about their priorities and concerns and informal events like this are a great way to get people talking,” Rutherford said.

Residents are encouraged to bring their own picnic lunch to the park. Free balloons will be provided to young children. The Supervisor and her family plan to arrive about 11 a.m. at the picnic tables.

Rutherford is hosting regular get-togethers to provide residents with an informal venue where they can speak with her. The events will be held at points of interest in the Second District. The first get-together was a walk on the Pacific Electric Trail in Rancho Cucamonga.

“I want these gatherings to have a friendly, casual atmosphere that encourages people to open up and tell me what’s on their minds,” Rutherford said.

Memorial Park encompasses 40 acres at 1100 Foothill Blvd. in Upland. The park features restrooms, picnic tables, and BBQ grills, as well as a playground, skatepark, basketball courts, and baseball fields.

Second District Supervisor Rutherford represents the cities of Fontana, Rancho Cucamonga, and Upland as well as the unincorporated communities of Crestline, Valley of Enchantment, Cedarpines Park, Lytle Creek, Mt. Baldy, San Antonio Heights, and Devore.
