Age Wise

Age Wise is a non-traditional mental health program for high-risk, under-served adults age 59 years or older who would benefit from behavioral health and wellness services and connections to resources.

Multipurpose Senior Services Program

The Multipurpose Senior Services Program (MSSP) fosters independent living in the community through services to Medi-Cal eligible individuals age 65 years or older to avoid or delay placement in nursing facilities.

**In-Home Supportive Services

In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) assists aged, blind or disabled individuals who are:

- ✓ Limited in their ability to care for themselves
- ✓ Unable to live safely at home without IHSS due to functional limitations
- ✓ Low-income

IHSS services are aimed at health and safety and are considered a better alternative to out-of-home care.

The Senior Information and Assistance (SIA) program serves seniors 60 years of age and older by providing information on programs and community resources as well as assistance and advocacy in obtaining those services when needed. Follow-up services are also provided to ensure seniors receive appropriate services.
