Please be advised that the County of San Bernardino, Department of Public Health, Division of Environmental Health Services – Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received a Registration Permit application for a Medium Volume Transfer/Processing Facility (MVTF) from the City of Claremont Community Services Department on December 9, 2021. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of San Bernardino, including all active transfer stations.

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<u>Description of Project and LEA's Determination</u>

The City of Claremont MVTF is an existing facility that collects community Municipal Solid Waste, Green Material, Recyclables, and Construction & Demolition material. The application proposes to incorporate accepting up to 40 tons per day of compostable materials (organics), as defined in 14 CCR § 17852, to be transferred for further processing. Furthermore, waste characterization activity to determine organics will be conducted at the Loading/Unloading area. These additions are a response to the upcoming Senate Bill 1383 – Short-Lived Climate Pollutants as a means to divert organic material from the landfills. The total incoming solid waste does not exceed 99.9 tons.

The LEA has reviewed the documents and accepts the permit application. A registration permit will be issued pursuant to 14 CCR § 18104.2.
