Please be advised the San Bernardino County, Department of Public Health, Division of Environmental Health Services – Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and accepted a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment for the CEMEX Black Mountain Quarry Plant EMSW Conversion Facility.

The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of San Bernardino, including all active transfer stations.

## Description of Project and LEA's Determination

On August 9, 2021, the LEA received a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) Application package from CEMEX Black Mountain Quarry Plant EMSW Conversion Facility (SWIS #36-AA-0484) to amend the Transfer Processing Report (TPR) in a form of an RFI amendment. The amendment is to update information based on "Findings" identified during the facility's 5-Year Permit Review Report. The changes included updates to current information and language in the TPR.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulation, Title 27, Section 21665, the LEA has determined the following:

- The proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified and adopted CEQA documents.
- The proposed changes are acceptable and consistent with state minimum standards.
- The proposed changes do not conflict with the terms and conditions of the current SWFP.

The LEA has approved and filed the proposed changes as amendments to the RFI on this date, September 2, 2021.
