Please be advised that the San Bernardino County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and accepted a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment to the Joint Technical Document (JTD) for Lander Sanitary Landfill (Facility). The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within San Bernardino County, including all including all active and closed landfills.

## Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

The Facility is located at 59200 Winters Road in Landers, California. On March 16, 2023 the LEA received a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application from the Facility. The SWFP application package to amend their current JTD in the form of an RFI amendment.

### The changes include:

• The use of Processed Construction and Demolition Wastes and Materials as alternative daily cover.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with state minimum standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA approved the amendment on April 14, 2023.
