Please be advised that the San Bernardino County, Department of Public Health, and Division of Environmental Health Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and accepted a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment to the current RFI for the Trona-Argus Refuse Disposal Site. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of San Bernardino, including all active and closed landfills.

### Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

The Trona-Argus Refuse Disposal Site, located approximately 1 mile West of Trona and 1 miles North of Angus, has submitted a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package to the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) on March 13, 2024. The purpose of this application is to amend the Report of Facility Information (RFI) based on the findings identified during the facility's 5-Year Permit Review, which was completed by the LEA on December 11, 2023.

The amendment to the Report of Facility Information (RFI) includes updates to various sections, including tables of content, purpose, inspection procedures, financial responsibility, references, figures, landfill gas data, cost estimates, and labor and equipment rates.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA accepted the amendment on April 11, 2024.
