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### 16K999 Complaint Inspection

**Inspector Comments:** A complaint inspection was conducted on this date in response to complaint number CO0088682 received by the San Bernardino County Environmental Health Services on 08/14/2023.

**NATURE OF COMPLAINT:** The complainant stated that a rat was spotted in the store eating through tortilla packets and other food items. Complainant also stated the facility continued to operate business as usual without sanitizing/disinfecting the affected area.

**OBSERVATION(S):** On this date, the following information was provided/observed:

- Employee stated that the facility is aware of this complaint and have seen the rat enter the facility on 08/12/2023.
- Person in charge indicated that the facility does not get pest control service.
- Observed evidence of several live and newly caught cockroaches (from nymph to adult) on sticky trap behind the two-door refrigeration unit adjacent to the break room entrance. (See violation #16C023).
- Observed multiple bags of tortillas on the display shelf with rodent chew marks.
- Employee stated that some prepackaged foods were observed to have been chewed by rat upon opening the facility on this date.
- Employee stated that any compromised/contaminated food products are discarded when found, and the affected areas were clean and sanitized.
- Observed employee wipe the affected area with hand sanitizer and towel. Employee stated the facility had just exhausted the last of their sanitizer solution, and owner/facility has not provided approved sanitizer to the facility.
- No vermin activity was observed at the fresh produce area.

**OUTCOME:**

- Eliminate vermin from the facility.
- Clean and sanitize affected areas.
- Provide approved sanitizer solution to properly sanitize all affected areas.
- Violation(s) observed on this date poses an immediate threat to the public health and safety and the health permit to operate is hereby suspended and facility ordered closed until the listed violation(s) have been corrected and verified by San Bernardino County Public Health Department Environmental Health Services.

Facility is to remain closed until proper sanitizing solution is provided and permission from DEHS is given. Contact San Bernardino County Environmental Health Services to schedule a re-inspection to reinstate the health permit. "Notice of closure" sign posted, do not move, hide, or remove sign.

**\*\*NOTE:** A re-inspection will be conducted in the future to observe compliance. Failure to comply may result in future billed inspections of \$245.00 per hour with a half hour minimum.

**CLOSURE SIGN POSTED ON ENTRANCE DOOR. DO NOT REMOVE OR RELOCATE CLOSURE SIGN.  
NON-COMPLIANCE WILL RESULT IN A CHARGED FOLLOW UP INSPECTION AT AN HOURLY RATE OF \$245.**

**Inspector Comments:** Observed multiple bags of tortillas on the display shelf to be adulterated. Observed rodent chew marks on the tortillas.

Ensure food intended for customer is in good condition and unadulterated.

Corrected on site. Employee discarded the adulterated foods.

**Violation Description:** All food shall be manufactured, produces, prepared, compounded, packed, transported, kept for sale, and served so as to be pure and free from adulteration and spoilage. Any food is adulterated if it bears or contains any poisonous or deleterious substance that may render it impure or injurious to health. ### 16C014 Food contact surfaces: clean and sanitized

**Inspector Comments:** No approved sanitizer solution was observed on this date.

Obtain/provide an approved sanitizer to disinfect all food and non-food contact surfaces.

Corrected on site: Violation(s) observed pose an immediate threat to the public health and safety and the health permit to operate is hereby suspended and facility ordered closed until the listed violation(s) have been corrected and verified by San Bernardino County Public Health Department Environmental Health Services.

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**Violation Description:** All food contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean and sanitized. (113984(e), 114097, 114099.1, 114099.4, 114099.6, 114101 (b-d), 114105, 114109, 114111, 114113, 114115 (a, b, d), 114117, 114125(b), 114135, 114141)

### 16C023 No rodents, insects, birds, or animals

**Inspector Comments:** Observed evidence of several live and newly caught cockroaches (from nymph to adult) on sticky trap behind the two-door refrigeration unit adjacent to the break room entrance.

Clean and sanitize all affected areas. Ensure facility is kept free of vermin at all times.

Corrected on site: Violation(s) observed pose an immediate threat to the public health and safety and the health permit to operate is hereby suspended and facility ordered closed until the listed violation(s) have been corrected and verified by San Bernardino County Public Health Department Environmental Health Services.

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**Violation Description:** Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)
