Senate Bill 1383 is a new law designed to reduce food waste by requiring food businesses to donate their extra edible food to registered organizations like yours!

By registering your LSCFO with Environmental Health Services, your organization can:



Help fight hunger in our county by providing food



Become an inspected and approved source of food



Join our regional network of food providers and other pantries



Waive your registration fee with proof of non-profit status
