CONSENT ITEMS:

The following consent items are expected to be routine and non-controversial and will be acted upon by the Commission at one time without discussion unless a request has been received prior to the hearing to discuss the matter.

- Consideration of: (1) CEQA Exemption as CEQA Lead Agency for LAFCO SC#500; and (2) LAFCO SC#500 – City of San Bernardino Irrevocable Agreement to Annex No. 2022-368 for Water and Sewer Service (APN 0270-161-14)

The proposed service contract is to provide water and sewer service to a single parcel, Assessor Parcel Number 0270-161-14. The service contract area comprises approximately 1.7 acres generally located on the north side of 40th Street, between Golden Avenue and Conejo Drive, within the City of San Bernardino's eastern sphere of influence.

- Consideration of: (1) CEQA Exemption as CEQA Lead Agency for LAFCO SC#501; and (2) LAFCO SC#501 – City of Chino Covenant Agreement to Annex for Sewer Service (APN 1023-071-43)

The proposed service contract is to provide sewer service to a single parcel, Assessor Parcel Number 1023-071-43. The service contract area comprises approximately 0.61 acres located at the northern terminus of Serenity Trail near the intersection of Chino Avenue and State Route 71, within the City of Chino's northwestern sphere of influence.

IF YOU CHALLENGE ANY DECISION REGARDING ANY OF THE ABOVE PROPOSALS IN COURT, YOU MAY BE LIMITED TO RAISING ONLY THOSE ISSUES YOU OR SOMEONE ELSE RAISED DURING THE PUBLIC TESTIMONY PERIOD REGARDING THAT PROPOSAL OR IN WRITTEN CORRESPONDENCE DELIVERED TO THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION AT, OR PRIOR TO, THE PUBLIC HEARING.

The Political Reform Act requires the disclosure of expenditures for political purposes related to a change of organization or reorganization proposal which has been submitted to the Commission, and contributions in support of or in opposition to such measures, shall be disclosed and reported to the same extent and subject to the same requirements as provided for local initiative measures presented to the electorate (Government Code Section 56700.1).
