D. United Way 2-1-1  E. HPN Update (All County)	Ken Bell	<p>Ken Bell presented general information on data collected by 2-1-1 on the trending needs in the Central Valley. 2-1-1 will provide more specific information as requested in future meetings.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Housing and food is a constant request in the Central Valley. But, housing is always the #1 unmet need, which accounts for 37% of the need. Healthcare also jumped up about 30% in December. Utility assistance payment requests has more doubled in the last 12 months because more children are at home and residents are working more from home.</li> <li>• In the coming weeks, 2-1-1 will be looking at the equity of information they are receiving to see if ethnicity and agree plays into that with respect to the homeless needs.</li> <li>• Jessica Alexander request that we get a specific data with respect to the 55 and over population.</li> <li>• Dr. Keres requests that there be a committee to look at the racial and ethnic inequalities. Ken Bell will research and coordinate with Dr. Keres on the matter.</li> <li>• Sharon Green, Countywide HPN Chair addressed the Central Valley HPN and talked about the County wide HPN strategies and needs of the agencies. She wants to make sure that provider voices are heard at the next meeting and throughout the year. She invited everyone to participate at the next meeting.</li> <li>• Levi Deatherage, Countywide HPN vice-chair also addressed the Central Valley and discussed the need to collaborate, as we are continuing to deal with the consequences of COVID-19 pandemic.</li> </ul>
