In September 2007, the San Bernardino County Homeless Partnership (SBCHP) was formed to provide a more focused approach to our goal of ending homelessness within the County. The Partnership consists of city governments, community based organizations, faith-based organizations, educational institutes, non-profit organizations, private industry, and federal, state, and local government.

SBCHP was developed to promote a strong collaboration between agencies to direct the planning, development, and implementation of the County's 10-year-plan to end chronic homelessness. The Partnership meets on the third Wednesday of each month at the Behavioral Health Resource Center in Rialto. The Partnership facilitates better communication, planning, coordination, and cooperation among all entities that provide services and/or resources for the relief of homelessness in San Bernardino County.

***The Mission of the San Bernardino County Homeless Partnership is to provide a system of care that is inclusive, well planned, coordinated and evaluated and is accessible to all who are homeless and those at-risk of becoming homeless.***

Step Up on Second	Kimberlee Albers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Nonprofit organization who has been a mental health service provider in Los Angeles County for the last 30 years</li> <li>• San Bernardino County was awarded bonus project and awarded to Step Up</li> <li>• Began in San Bernardino in October 2016</li> <li>• True Housing First Model using 5 Core Principles</li> <li>• Uses a recovery based model</li> <li>• Individualized and client driven</li> <li>• Tenant based rental assistance with field based mental health services which is long term housing support for 112 people with an additional 19 for a total of 131 permanent supportive housing units</li> <li>• For individuals with mental health disability who are chronically homeless which must be documented</li> <li>• Can serve those with zero income, drug charges and 290 status but unable to serve undocumented</li> <li>• Can serve families</li> <li>• Refer through 211 CES to do assessment. DBH can direct refer.</li> </ul>
