In September 2007, the San Bernardino County Homeless Partnership (SBCHP) was formed to provide a more focused approach to our goal of ending homelessness within the County. The Partnership consists of city governments, community based organizations, faith-based organizations, educational institutes, non-profit organizations, private industry, and federal, state, and local government.

SBCHP was developed to promote a strong collaboration between agencies to direct the planning, development, and implementation of the County’s 10-year-plan to end chronic homelessness. The Partnership meets on the third Wednesday of each month at the Behavioral Health Resource Center in Rialto. The Partnership facilitates better communication, planning, coordination, and cooperation among all entities that provide services and/or resources for the relief of homelessness in San Bernardino County.

***The Mission of the San Bernardino County Homeless Partnership is to provide a system of care that is inclusive, well planned, coordinated and evaluated and is accessible to all who are homeless and those at-risk of becoming homeless.***

(WDD) Offices in Rancho Cucamonga, San Bernardino, Victorville	Steve Earl	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>WDD is funded by US Dept. of Labor partners and partners with State Employment Development Dept. and Temp agencies to match employees with employers.</li> <li>Employment access through WDD every 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesdays at WDD – Employers and Temp agencies take applications for employment. Currently lots of work available.</li> <li>WDD services applications requires Social Security Number and a CA ID.</li> <li>Challenge for homeless is that they don't have a permanent address to get a CA ID.</li> <li>WDD provides paid training opportunities, and can assist with transportation vouchers. Includes helping those who want to improve their employment skills.</li> <li>Focus on those leaving prison/jail, vets</li> <li>Additional supports through TAD - Transitional Assistance Needy Families (TANF) to help parents get training and/or employment with childcare.</li> <li>WIOA – Workforce, Innovative Opportunity Act – arrange training and employment for youth</li> </ul>
