In September 2007, the San Bernardino County Homeless Partnership (SBCHP) was formed to provide a more focused approach to our goal of ending homelessness within the County. The Partnership consists of city governments, community based organizations, faith-based organizations, educational institutes, non-profit organizations, private industry, and federal, state, and local government.

SBCHP was developed to promote a strong collaboration between agencies to direct the planning, development, and implementation of the County's 10-year-plan to end chronic homelessness. The Partnership meets on the third Wednesday of each month at the Behavioral Health Resource Center in Rialto. The Partnership facilitates better communication, planning, coordination, and cooperation among all entities that provide services and/or resources for the relief of homelessness in San Bernardino County.

Mission Statement

The Mission of the San Bernardino County Homeless Partnership is to provide a system of care that is inclusive, well planned, coordinated and evaluated and is accessible to all who are homeless and those at-risk of becoming homeless.



Program (EFSP)	Wytke Visser	<p>The Emergency Food and Shelter Program was established in 1983</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • They are currently on Phase 35 through 3/31/19 and the amount of funding is typically 1-1.2 million per year based on homeless and unemployment numbers. • EFSP Local Board funded 30 agencies in Phase 35 ranging from \$2,500 to \$300,000 • Typical grant is \$5,000 to \$30,000 (\$1,000 is minimum grant) • Phase 36 Application will be out soon and can only be applied for via email only • Have to be a 501 c3 non-profit to apply and provide eligible emergency services: Emergency food provider, Shelter provider (emergency or transitional), Motel voucher provider, Rental and or Utility assistance provider. • Agency may have a police for recipients to receive assistance for example: one time every 2 years, but has to be consistent to all. • Shelters work on a per diem bases • Hotel vouchers, Rental/Utilities assistance is only for up to one month per phase • EFSP is emergency money and must be spent when received. • Gift cards can be purchased to hand out only if they can be marked/encoded "Food Only" or "Food and Diapers Only" includes feminine hygiene • Rental checks have to be made no more than 10 days before due date • Tips for applying describe the need, not what you do
