- Strategic Planning & Systems Support RFP 23-03 Was released September 28, 2023.
- Racial Equity Analysis RFP 23-04 is in the revision process and the anticipated release date will be within a week or so.
- HHAP 4 The recommendation to distribute HHAP 4 funding based on the PIT Count was approved at the September 27th ICH Meeting. No modifications were made to the regional allocations as in the past. The Central Valley Region will receive the full PIT allocated amount of \$2,094,209.32.
- **HHAP 5** The NOFA was released on September 29, 2023, and a committee will be working with the OHS and Chief Marcus Dillard to develop the Local Action Plan with specific outcome goals that are required for the HHAP 5 application that is due March 27, 2024.
- **Regional Access Centers** Aziza Manuel from Inland So Cal United Way announced that two agencies for the Central Valley were awarded the funding to provide Regional Access services. The awarded agencies are Family Assistance Program and the Benjamine E. Jones Resource Center.

PRESENTATION:

- Community Health Worker Training & Partnership Opportunity "The Pair Team" Cooper Schoenthaler from "the Pair Team" presented on the work they are doing in the Inland Empire. They provide vulnerable patients with quality medical care by partnering with medical providers and community-based organizations to help the most in need to overcome barriers and get supportive wrap around services needed for their whole person care. - City of Colton With HHAP funding, the city is assisting residents with Homeless Prevention, Rapid Re-Housing and Bridge Housing. Other services include Holiday Food and a Diaper Distribution Program. For rental assistance (HP and RRH) the application is available online or call 909-370-5087.
- City of San Bernardino Working to collaborate and network with all agencies and non-profits to better serve the city residents most in need.
- The Sheriffs Hope Team is expanding their team and was introduced for the first time at our CVRSC. They will be formally presented at the next ICH meeting.
- The City of Redlands is expanding their outreach efforts and working in collaboration with Stepup, Salvation Army, and the Sheriff's Hope Team.

DISCUSSION:

• With the PIT date for the unsheltered homeless count set for January 23, 2024, Pastor Jessica opened up the discussion that it is not mandated to facilitate an unsheltered count every year. It is only mandated every other year. Currently only the shelter count is a yearly mandate. One point of discussion was to defer our count for 2024 so that our CoC can better plan for delivery of current homeless population needs. The majority of members voiced that they preferred to still do the homeless count, as although just a snapshot in time, it helps them gage their needs. OHS Chief Dilliard is conferring with our HUD representative to see if there would be any consequences or loss of funding if the count is deferred.
