Approve Meeting Minutes from November 16, 2023		Recommendation by Astrid Johnson to approve minutes, 2 nd from Glenn Harris, noting incorrect date on minutes. Roll call vote taken; motion passed unanimously.

	Curtis Yakimow	Asked Debra to give an update regarding PITC.
	Debra Breidenbach	Discussed the PITC flyer information and it was made available to the committee and to attendees. The flyer is to assist in recruiting volunteers for the PITC, January 25, 2024. Maps for Morongo Valley, Yucca Valley, Joshua Tree and 29 Palms expected back to OHS by December 8th. Debra posed the question as to whether there should be in-person training versus virtual training. The committee and some attendees said in-person training is preferred. The training will take place on January 18, 2024.
	Curtis Yakimow	Brought up if there should be only one deployment center or to keep it at two deployment centers. It was agreed to keep two deployment centers. Octavious and Shelley mentioned keeping two deployment locations makes it easier for people to reach one or the other depending on where they are coming from. Shelley recommended funding by the cities for sleeping bags for day of PITC.
	Astrid Johnson	MB Arch provided a recap of funds for HHAP 1 & 2. Astrid provided a summary report of HHAP 1 and will send Debra a chart from 2021 to present. Astrid reviewed the HHAP 2 budget report and referred to the report information she brought with her. Curtis recommended sending the reports to the committee to see if her reports are readable, understandable, acceptable and in a usable fashion. Curtis mentioned keeping this on as a future agenda item.

Steering Committee/Public Comments		Glenn Harris – Mr. Harris mentioned that Supervisor Dawn Rowe and District Attorney Jason Anderson will be meeting for a Public Safety Meeting being held November 29th. He provided a flyer for distribution.
		Octavious Scott – Mr. Scott informed the group that since City of 29 Palms Town Manager, Frank Lukino, recently left the City, they are looking to hire an interim City Manager.
		Faith Nicholson – Faith gave a brief update indicating that TAY services are still free to 18- to 25-year-old individuals in need of such services.
		Astrid Johnson – Spoke of getting the women's house back, that housing is full. Regarding the Entry House Meeting, she is trying to pull street outreach together, trying to address getting everyone housed.
		Robin Schlosser – Mentioned that there will be a Food Semi Truck distribution event (36,000 lbs) happening on January 26 th at the Church of Latter-Day Saints in 29 Palms. A 501c3 must be provided if one would like to get some items to distribute.
		Shelley Licata – She discussed a scholarship supporting young woman going back to school, which will award 1st, 2nd and 3rd place cash prizes. Judging will be in January. Deadline is December 15th.
		Deputy Javier Lopez – Prior to recently being promoted to Deputy, he was on the Quality of Life Team, which covered the entire Morongo Basin regarding homelessness, graffiti, etc. He mentioned the position is to be filled in January/February 2024.
		Carrie Tish – Provided information regarding a free Narcan training class to be held November 28th.
