Healthcare in Action	Ed Menacho Street Medicine	Re: Healthcare in Action – teams around So.Calif. Started here in February. We are a street-medicine agency, which we will define and explain today. Stress medicine is providing care, exactly where the homeless are, and on their own terms to maximally, reduce or eliminate barriers to care. It is visiting people where they live in alleyways under bridges, urban encampments, or wherever they are. We do both street medicine and managed care. It is Sustainable Healthcare Model for Homeless adults. And we do Community Support Services to try to help our clients to get housed and, if possible, employed

		 First thing we do in dangerous situation, we show up with donations, start honest communication, and help them if it is their choice. We try to find out who is the lead person in an encampment and start with them and with the sickest person in the encampment.
