Wide Range of Work on Behalf of the Homeless/At -Risk Population with Emphasis on Victorville Wellness Center	Elisabel Castillo of Hope the Mission	(Elisabel joined us via telephone due to computer glitch.) Elisabel Castillo, Senior Regional Director of Programs for Hope the Mission, presented on the Victorville Wellness Center and shelter operations, highlighting the services provided, partnerships, and plans for expansion in San Bernardino County. The facility offers 150 beds, including pods for families, with a minimum 90-day stay and case-by-case extensions based on individual goals. Elisabel discussed the services provided at Hope the Mission, including laundry and janitorial work, and the availability and management of restrooms and showers, particularly in response to any illicit drug activity.

		Elisabel Castillo discussed the services and support offered at the Victorville and San Diego locations, including the dog park, kennels, animal control, and partnerships with the city for interim housing locations. Wendell Wilson asked about the size and management of interim housing sites, funding sources, and the possibility of permanent housing. The organization primarily operates tiny home villages and family shelters, with most funding coming from government contracts and fundraising efforts, including thrift stores. The meeting also included discussions on transportation services, maintenance delays, and safety concerns related to the pods at the Victorville Wellness site. Elisabel Castillo expressed gratitude before leaving the meeting.

Member Roundtable & Public Comment	Wendell	OTHER DISCUSSION/SHARING: Wendell Wilson discussed the success of a car program for the homeless and low- income individuals in Tacoma, emphasizing the positive impact it had on their ability to find jobs and support their families. Wendell further described elements of homeless services in Washington State. Senator Ochoa Bogh's Field Rep Armando Martinez provided insights into the efforts of the senator's office to address homelessness, highlighting proposed bills and an ongoing audit on public safety. Mr. Martinez invited all to contact the office of the Senator for support for any of the funding projects they may be initiating.
