

AGENCY NAME: COMMUNITY ACTION PARTNERSHIP OF SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY

DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES:

Family Development Program - provides emergency assistance in the areas of motel vouchers, rental assistance, food, transportation assistance, and miscellaneous services; operates a transitional housing program; and supportive case management. FDP offers discounted DMV photo ID assistance and youth programs such as backpack school supplies, summer camp and Christmas adoption. The Moving Families Forward program offers supportive services, educational opportunities including financial literacy and personal development. Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) - assists low-income taxpayers with free income tax preparation services, to help them access tax credits such as the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) and the Child Tax Credit (CTC). We also offer a mobile shower and laundry program.

Provides millions of pounds of food annually at no charge through the following programs: USDA Commodities; Salvage Food; Congregate Feeding/Soup Kitchens; Senior Choice Nutrition Program; Campus Cupboard Program, and Food Farmacy.
